### PARENT INFORMATION AND FINAL CONSENT FORM FOR SCHOOL EXCURSION

Dear Parents

I am pleased to provide you with the following details regarding our Albany Camp on 22 to 26 March 2021.

This excursion has been planned to develop students' understanding of History, Science, Health and the role the Defence Force plays in our community. This will supplement the work being completed in your son's/daughter's classroom prior to, and upon return from the excursion.

The year 6 students will depart from **Golden Bay Primary at 0900 hours on Monday 22 March** and return to **Golden Bay Primary at 1515 hours on Friday 26 March** – see attached itinerary for full details of activities.

Travel will be by: Peel Bus Charters.

Accommodation will be at Camp Quaranup, Quaranup Road, Vancouver Peninsula, WA 6330  
Students will be in single gender shared rooms. Supervisory staff will be in adjacent rooms within close proximity.

# Albany Camp - What to bring... what not to bring.

## Items to bring

### **Suitcase or soft bag**

Pyjamas - Warm

Bed socks

Underwear - at least 5 pairs

Socks - at least 5 pairs

Shoes - at least two pairs. Sneakers / enclosed shoes (**No heels, thongs, sandals**)

Full school uniform & school jumper – to be worn on tours to National ANZAC Centre, Whaling Station and Tree Top Walk.

Waterproof jacket / raincoat

Long pants - cargo pants / tracksuit

Hat

Optional Items - thermals / scarves / gloves.

**Toiletries** - Toothbrush & Toothpaste / Shampoo & Conditioner & Body Wash (travel size). Hair Brush.

### **NO MAKE-UP & NO HAIR STRAIGHTENERS**

Single bed fitted sheet (needed to cover mattress)

Sleeping bag

Pillow and pillow case

Blanket (it can get quite cool in Albany at night)

Please note: ***Even if your child brings a sleeping bag, for health reasons a sheet must be provided to cover the mattress.***

## Pocket Money Guidelines

A limit of \$50 spending money had been set. We would like to keep the money safe as possible. The money is to be placed in a plastic zip-lock bag with the amount and student name on it. Spending money will be collected by school staff prior to getting on the bus and will be provided to the children as needed.

## Medication

*All necessary medication needs to be clearly labelled and given to school staff at the school on check in. Please do not under any circumstances put Panadol or similar products into children's bags. All medication MUST have an accompanying Medical Action Plan, Medication will not be accepted at the airport without a pre-completed plan. Please see Cherie Raymond at least a week prior to camp to arrange.*

## Weather

Temperatures range from around 16 degrees to 23 degrees—please provide comfortable daytime and evening wear to accommodate the temperature range.

## Mobile Phones

Students will **not** be able to take mobile phones on the Camp. If there are particular circumstances, staff will negotiate the use of the school phone to contact family. Parents will need to discuss such arrangements with supervising staff. You may also be contacted by a staff member if the need arises.

**NO OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES - eg iPods, Portable Games Consoles.**
