



Dear Parents,

A big hello from all staff at Golden Bay Primary School. I hope that all is well with you and your family as we all continue our home based activities/work.

I've just listened to the Premier's update. It contained a great deal of information, care for Western Australians impacted by the fires, and optimism amidst our emergency situations.

No further local cases have been identified. The Premier and WA Chief Health Officer have instructed us to remain at home, wear masks when outside for essential supplies or exercise, and continue with C19 testing. The message urged of us to get tested if we experience any symptoms, even if we have had an initial test. We are also being encouraged to be re-tested given the virus can take up to 14 days to fully develop.

The Premier is likely to provide an updated statement tomorrow regarding schools and expectations of us all should the restrictions be lifted. Stay tuned, and let's hope that everything continues to go to plan. Safety of all Western Australians is a primary focus at this time.

Again, our thoughts are with colleagues and families impacted by the fires. Another huge call out to all our emergency workers who are amazing!

My special thanks is extended to our P&C Executive Officers who are supporting the communication with parents. It's been said many times before but worth saying again - we are all in this together! Stay safe and support each other in any way you can while in lockdown.
